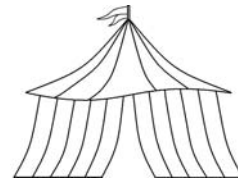
**"Spring Open House"**

#### **Enroll for Summer and Fall 2022!!**

If you have not already done so, please return your intent to continue form for Summer and Fall 2022. We will have open enrollment for new students April 4<sup>th</sup>, so it is important for us to know if your child will be here for our "Summer Exploration Series". If your child will not be attending this summer you need to fill out a withdraw notice by May 1<sup>st</sup> to give your 30 days notice and ensure that your deposit will be applied to your last month of tuition.

Our summer session covers June & July. We will also pro-rate August for anyone who will be starting at FUSD *only if space is available*. Our Fall session begins on Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

#### **Arriving at school:**

Please sign-in at time of arrival, and then escort your child outside. Staying inside is not a choice at this time. Teachers are preparing for the day and are not able to supervise students while preparing for the day's activities. They are available to talk to parents with questions, concerns, and comments, but do not have time to visit with each individual child. If your conversation will be extensive, please schedule to meet with your child's teacher at a time that works for everyone. Thank you!

#### **Late Pick-up Fees:**

Please be sure to pick-up your child at your scheduled time. There is a \$10.00 late fee for every 10 min. you are late. "Late" refers to any time after your child's scheduled pick-up time. This includes 11:30, 12:30, 3:30, 4:30 or 5:30 depending on schedule. The fee will be added to your monthly statement.

#### **What to Wear to School?**

Please send your child to school with appropriate jacket, hat, etc. for the ever-changing spring weather of Flagstaff. We go outside everyday and want each

student to be comfortable and enjoy outside activity. Also, children need sturdy play shoes that allow them to develop gross motor skills. Please, no flip flops. **And don't forget to label all belongings....**
