Lunch and Snack Reminders:

Arriving at school:

Teachers are preparing for the day and are not able to supervise students while preparing for the day's activities. They are available to talk to parents with questions, concerns, and comments, but do not have time to visit with each individual child. If your conversation will be extensive, please schedule to meet with your child's teacher

at a time that works for everyone. Thank you!
