Other Foresight News:

Our Front Entry:

The sign-in books and some parent information are located on the counter in our entry room. We ask that if you are waiting to pick up your child at 11:30 or 3:30, please wait in this room to chat with other parents (& to minimize disturbances to the front classroom) Please do not share the code with your children, or let them enter the buttons or hang on the door handle. It is a rather expensive system and should not be included as part of your child's routine to enter the school. Thank you for your cooperation! Also, you are required by ADHS to sign-in and sign-out your child before entering the second entrance.

You're Account:

Please remember there is an annual registration fee in August. We understand that prices of everything keep rising. We are trying our best to help as much as we can, so we have postponed our tuition increase until closer to January (when minimum wage goes up again). We will send out the new rate increase and keep you informed of changes as it gets closer.

Also, we are enclosing a standard registration policy that needs to be initialed, signed and returned to Kori ASAP. Tuition is due by the 5th of each month.

**** This policy, along with all policies stated in enrollment paperwork will be enforced as of August 1, 2024, due to an increase in enrollment and a long waitlist of families eagerly wanting to enroll at our school.

Arrival Time and Pick-up Time:

Please have your child here 10 minutes before his or her scheduled time. Late arrivals can be very disruptive to the classroom, the teacher's lesson, and can upset children who have difficulty seeing parents come and go. Also, we will be enforcing our late fee charge of \$20.00(for each child) for every 10 minutes you are late. We understand that situations occur occasionally, but late pick-up will result in additional fees to your account. This policy is to guarantee that we stay in ratio, children are not waiting (which can cause anxiety) and teachers are not required to supervise children during their prep time, lunch time, or break time. Thank you for your consideration of our staff.

Bathroom Accidents:

Please provide a change of clothes in your child's backpack in case of a bathroom accident, we have some clothes for emergencies, but most children are more comfortable in their own clothes. If your child does have an accident, please be sure to get your child's soiled clothes from the hamper in the girl's bathroom. All soiled clothes will be disposed of every Friday at 5:30 PM.

Contact Information:

It is required by law that we are able to contact you or someone local if there is an emergency involving your child. If we do not have a contact number while your child is a school, we are forced to call DCS-Department of Child Safety in case of emergency (the last thing we want to do). This means if you are out of town for the day, or you give us numbers that are not accurate you put us (and your child) in a very uncomfortable position.

Foresight Communication:

We will continue to send all communications via e-mail; monthly tuition, newsletter, special events, closures, holidays, and daily routines. We also have our outside display cabinet at the entrance with lesson plans and reminders. Lastly, you can put our website as a favorite on your computer
