Special Events

Independence Day:

Sunscreen:

Please apply sunscreen to your child before coming to school. It should be a brand that has a high SPF 30+ and should be waterproof/long lasting. More importantly, please send your child to school with a wide-brim hat/baseball hat, protective sunglasses, and A long sleeve sun protective shirt. We are fortunate that our backyard play area has a lot of shade, and hopefully the combined use of these sun safety items is effective for your child. If you have further questions, please talk to Beth.

Enrollment and Withdraw Policy:

If you are now enrolled, we will assume you will continue with us in August unless we receive a notice of withdrawal by July 1st. If you wish to **change** your schedule for the upcoming Fall semester, simply fill out a schedule change form ASAP and we will accommodate your needs to the best of our abilities. If you are leaving, be sure to fill out a withdraw form at least 30 days prior to your child's last day of school. This will allow us to apply your last full month of tuition to your bill. All forms are in the tree shelves in the front entrance, or please ask for one at drop off or pick up.

Lunch Time Reminders:

Please be aware of choking hazards for your child's snacks and lunch. Do not put items such as hotdogs, uncut grapes, carrots, and popcorn, etc. Also, please do NOT send any meat that is still attached to a bone or tough jerky. We follow the standard of "if it fits down a toilet paper tube, it is a hazard."

Our school year begins August 3rd and FUSD School begins August 10th!

If you have not already requested to have your child stay the first week of August, please do asap because there are only a few spots available and we may not be able to accommodate all requests. Thank you for your understanding and hopefully this will allow you to find alternative care that week if we are not able.

FLC Private Kindergarten

We wanted to make sure that all families are aware that our school offers private kindergarten. The class size will be 15 students, so your child will continue to get the individual attention we can provide to prepare him or her for 1st grade. We follow the AZ kindergarten standards-if not exceed them. Please talk with Beth or Kori if you have any questions. Also, those children who might possibly be ready for kindergarten, but miss the entry date due to a later birthday should consider our private Kindergarten. There are some specific guidelines for private kindergarten enrollment that we would be happy to discuss with you if you feel your child would benefit from this placement. It has proven to be a very positive transition for our students!

Emergency and Evacuation Procedures:

We do have emergency procedures in place specifically for Flagstaff's fire

season and we are registered with reverse 911, so they will immediately inform Foresight of any local threats, which will help eliminate any mixed information on our end. It is also required (a law) that you or an authorized contact person can always be reached by phone at any time if we need you, ****Please be sure you always give us any contact updates.** Our priority is your child's safety and security. See attached Emergency policy form, that in the future will be in our parent handbook. Thank you.

Our Staff:

We have several staff changes that have happened or are going to happen. Jena's last day with us is June 26. After 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ years with us, she will be pursuing a career direction that has landed her at the downtown library. Registration Fee and 2026 Tuition:

Annual Registration fees will be added to your account in August for those

who will be continuing in the 2026-2027 program. Tuition will remain the same at this time, and be reassessed in January (when the lovely minimum wage increase occurs 🙄)
